PINWHEEL (5)
A pinwheel hooked rug from Shaker Workshops is adapted from an optional late 19th-century rug discovered at the Shaker Village in Canterbury, New Hampshire. The hand-hooked wool rug costs about \$149 for 3'-diameter size. The 5' rug is about \$409. (800) 840-9121, shakerworkshops.com

PETITE CHANDELIER (6)
Mounted on a metal center body with a finial pendant, Authentic Designs' four-arm chandelier is finished in special pewter with optional waxed candle sleeves. It measures 17½" high x 14" in diameter. All fixtures are handmade to order. It sells for \$376. (800) 844-9416, authenticdesigns.com

SINK WITH A TWIST (7)
With its traditional detailing along the rim, the Porcelain Twist sink from American Standard is easy to retrofit into an existing 20" x 14" vanity cutout. The self-rimming, drop-in sink accepts a 4" center faucet. The china sink costs \$150. (800) 451-1122, americanstandard-us.com

BLUE BULL'S-EYE (8)
Exclusive to Lehman's, the Aladdin blue bull's-eye lamp is based on a design used in pioneer homes from Nova Scotia to the Yukon. The 26"-high cobalt-blue lamp has a brass burner that burns up to nine hours. The limited-edition lamp costs \$209. (888) 438-5346, lehman's.com

BERKS FANCY (9)
The fancy painted hanging cupboard from Adam Mathews Furniture Maker is an accurate re-creation of a 1780 piece from Berks County, Pennsylvania, which Adam documented when it came up for auction.
